
Letter dated November 2, 1944, from

Letter dated November 20, 1944 from
Harry G. Denton, City Clerk, stating
the City Council requested the Civil
Service Board to study and prepare a report relative to provisions of

November 30, 1944

Section 71 of the City Charter which reads in part as follows:

"In determining the salaries of persons in the employ of the City, the City Council shall take into consideration the time of service of said persons and shall grant increases in salaries to such persons at the end of 5, 10 and 15 years of continuous service."

The Civil Service Board instructed the Secretary to inquire of other cities relative to their service salary procedures and to prepare a report of findings.

Re: CLASSIFICATIONS OF
CLERICAL POSITIONS

A letter dated November 20, 1944,
received from Harry G. Denton, City
Clerk, stating a motion was adopted

by the City Council on the above date, requesting the Civil Service Board and the City Manager to make an investigation of all clerical positions in the City to ascertain if said positions are classified correctly and properly paid, said report to be submitted within 60 days. After discussion by the Civil Service Board, a motion was made by Mr. Cavanaugh requesting an appropriation of \$2500.00 be made by the City Council to conduct such an investigation, this money to be used to defray the expenses of additional clerical help; seconded by Mr. Deise, thereupon becoming the order of the Board.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION
POLICE WOMAN

Ordinance No. 1030, 4th Series, adopted
by the City Council on November 27, 1944,
provides for the appointment of eight

Police Women at a salary of \$170 per month and said Police Women shall be subject to any and all rules, regulations and charter provisions referring to regular Police Men. Said Police Women shall have authority to enforce traffic laws. The Secretary was instructed to submit the medical examination form now used in examination of Patrolmen and Firemen to a woman physician, said physician to determine the necessary changes in the present medical form. Recommendations to be submitted to the Board at the next regular meeting.

Hoskinson, Chief Engineer, Division of Water, setting forth certain facts relative to the status of Mr. Lazzarini. After discussion, the Civil Service Board instructed the Secretary to inform Mr. Lazzarini and Mr. Hoskinson to be present at its next regular meeting. No action was taken at this time.




