

ORDINANCE NO. 1613, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1241, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED DECEMBER 27, 1946, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DISASTERS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING TWO NEW SUB-SECTIONS THERETO TO BE KNOWN AS SUB-SECTIONS "L" AND "M".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1241, Fourth Series, passed December 27, 1946, is hereby amended by adding a new sub-section thereto to be known as Sub-section "L":


L. Radiological Defense Division. The chief of this division shall be a citizen experienced and with the necessary scientific and academic background to qualify him for this position. It will be the responsibility of this division to provide a well defined plan for radiological defense for the City of Sacramento to include evaluation of hazard, exposure standards, methods of detection, organization and training of appropriate personnel and the coordination and operation of this plan with the over-all Civil Defense Plan of the City of Sacramento.

SECTION 2: Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1241, Fourth Series, passed December 27, 1946, is hereby further amended by adding another new sub-section thereto to be known as Sub-section "M":

M. Warden Service Division. The chief of this division shall be a citizen, a person with civic interest and one who has organizational and administrative ability. It will be the responsibility of this division to plan and develop the policies, procedures, leadership and training of the Warden Service Division for the ultimate effectiveness of an organized self-protection program.


