

ORDINANCE NO. **3607** FOURTH SERIES

ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3597, FOURTH SERIES; ADDING SEC. 34.111 TO THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO RETIREMENT; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1

Ordinance No. 3597, Fourth Series, is hereby repealed.

Section 2

Sacramento City Code Section 34.111 is hereby added to read as follows:

Sec. 34.111. Deferred Compensation

(a) The election by an employee to defer compensation or the deferring of compensation by the City shall not be taken into account or otherwise have an effect in determining an employee's compensation for purposes of calculating retirement contributions or benefits.

(b) The receipt of deferred compensation shall not affect the receipt of any retirement allowance or benefit.

Section 3

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being the necessity to avoid inadvertent repeal of a section of the Retirement Chapter of the Code.

Section 4

This ordinance shall be published once within ten days after enactment in the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento.
