

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO
NOVEMBER 16TH, 1938.

The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at the hour of 10:00 o'clock P.M. Mayor Tom E. Monk presiding and Roll Call answered as follows:

Councilmen Anderson, Arnold, Bidwell, Coughlin, Harry, Kunz, Monk, Truesdale, Welsh.

Call for the Meeting was ordered filed.

The purpose of the meeting being the inspection of the proposed extension of 53rd Street southerly from "J" Street and "K" Street westerly from 54th Street and to consider any other matters which might be brought before the City Council.

Councilman Kunz introduced the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 444

"WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has, in the passing of MICHAEL FRANCIS CONNORS on this date, lost an admired and beloved citizen and former public official and employee, who served as a member of the Civil Service Board and as an employee of the Water Department, respectively, for the long tenure of nineteen years,

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby acknowledges the faithful services of said MICHAEL FRANCIS CONNORS and does extend to his widow and family its heartfelt sympathy and deepest sorrow in their bereavement; and

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the Minutes of the City Council and a copy thereof be sent to the bereaved family, and that when the Council adjourns, it adjourn out of respect to the Memory of said MICHAEL FRANCIS CONNORS."

Councilman Kunz moved that foregoing resolution be adopted.

Seconded by Councilman Coughlin and carried by the following vote:
