SUBJECT: Sacramento Sports Commission - At-Large Positions

This report recommends that City Council, by resolution, approve two additional at-large members to the Sacramento Sports Commission.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Council and County Board of Supervisors adopted companion ordinances establishing the Sacramento Sports Commission on June 8 and June 14, 1989, respectively.

On February 14, 1989, City Ordinance No. 88-039 Section 60.152 (a) (6) and 60.153 (b) (c) and County Ordinance No. SCC 0732 Section 2.150.030 (a) (6) and 2.125.040 (b) (c) were amended to increase the number of at-large positions on the Sacramento Sports Commission from two to four members. Two of the members must represent the interest of female competition in athletics. The recruitment and receiving of applications for at-large candidates was the responsibility of the Clerk of the County Board of Supervisors. Twenty applications were filed by the closing date.

The commission members reviewed all applications and ranked all candidates. A commission subcommittee interviewed the most qualified applicants. Their recommendations were placed on the Sports Commission agenda on April 6, 1989 and were approved by the full commission.

The commission's recommendations to the City Council and Board of Supervisors for their approval are as follows:

With the Board of Supervisors and City Council approval of the appointments, the commission plans to seat the two at-large members to the Sacramento Sports Commission at their May 4, 1989 meeting.




RECOMMENDATION
