
**A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE

THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT TO
THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE MCCLELLAN
AIR FORCE BASE/WATT AVENUE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan for the McClellan Air Force Base/Watt Avenue Project ("Redevelopment Plan") had to be created in an urgent manner to eliminate the blight existing both on and off the base,


WHEREAS, Section 33492.18 of the State Community Redevelopment Law (CRL) Health and Safety Code 33000 *et. seq.* enables the Redevelopment Agency to delay the requirements for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Redevelopment Plan

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. That the Redevelopment Agency of the City hereby finds and determines based on evidence in the record and all documents referenced therein, that the need to adopt a redevelopment plan at the soonest possible time requires a delay of the requirement to prepare an environmental document to meet the needs of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Upon which time the environmental impact report will be certified.
