A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE & POLICE ALARM SYSTEM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That the offer of the United States of America to the City of Sacramento to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of Fire & Police Alarm System, Docket No, Calif. 1201-(R), Project: Fire & Police Alarm System, a copy of which offer reads as follows:-

Subject to the Rules and Regulations (PWA Form No. 179, as amended to date) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of a central fire and police alarm office building and installation of a fire and police alarm system (herein called the "Project") by making a grant to City of Sacramento, of 45 percent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$120,703.

be and the same is hereby in all respects accepted.

SECTION 2. That said City of Sacramento agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations relating to such grant, a copy of which rules and regulations were annexed to the Government's offer and made a part thereof.

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works three certified copies of

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of this Resolution and three certified copies of the proceedings of this City Council in connection with the adoption of this Resolution, and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works.

SECTION 4. It is hereby covenanted that work on the project described in the Offer will be commenced as early as possible but in no event later than November 15, 1936; that the work will be planned so that it will reach a substantial peak before March 1, 1937; and that the project will be completed by November 1, 1937.
