

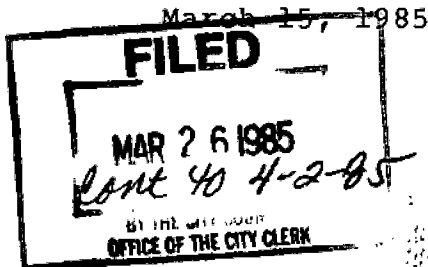

Re: Operations Agreement for the Light
Rail Transit Line Summary

Honorable Members in Session:

Discussion:

Council has approved two previous construction contracts for the construction of the light rail system. The agreement for the actual operations of the system has been negotiated, and adoption of the appropriate resolution is recommended.

Background:

Regional Transit will operate the RT Metro system upon completion of this system, in accordance with previously approved contracts. City staff, including the City Attorney's office, the Department of Public Works, and Risk Management, have negotiated a contract with Regional Transit. This agreement outlines and delineates the rights and duties of Regional Transit as the operator of the system within the City of Sacramento.

Financial Data:

The agreement basically requires the Regional Transit to bear all of the costs related to or resulting from the operation, maintenance and repair of the RT Metro system within the boundaries of the City of Sacramento. Certain indirect costs, however, will be incurred by the City of Sacramento during the life of the agreement. These costs would include staff time and expense in coordinating construction, maintenance or repair to City facilities that interface or are contiguous to the light rail system. It is not possible to estimate the amount of these costs, but it is not believed that they will be substantial.


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The City has accepted an indemnification from Regional Transit for its operation for personal injury resulting from its operation that indemnifies the City for its passive negligence but not its active negligence. The City will be an additional insured on Regional Transit's insurance policy in the amount of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) covering bodily injury, personal injury and property damage. With regard to the design of the system itself, and any claims arising out of defect of design, the City has received a total indemnification from Regional Transit for such claims.

Recommendation


It is recommended that the attached resolution approving the light rail operations agreement be adopted.
