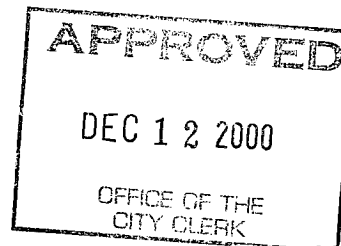

SUBJECT: DESIGNATION OF FOUR WEEKS FOR YEAR 2001 IN WHICH REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS NEED NOT BE HELD; RESCHEDULING OF OTHER MEETINGS REGULARLY SCHEDULED FOR TUESDAY(S) ON WHICH CONFLICTS OCCUR

SUMMARY:

▶ **Summer/Winter Recess for 2001**

- July 2 - July 13 [first and second week of July, 2001] will serve as the summer recess.
- December 17 - December 31, 2001 [third and fourth week of December, 2001] will serve as the winter recess.

▶ **National Night Out**

- August 7, 2001 - both afternoon and evening meetings will move to Thursday, August 9th.

▶ Election Date

... A special election to fill the vacancy in District 1 is scheduled for Tuesday, April 10, 2001. In the past we have not rescheduled meetings held on an election day of this type since the effect is on the vacant district and is not usually an intrusion on current seated members.

▶ Annual Capitol to Capitol Trip

... The Metro Chamber of Commerce annual 'Cap to Cap' will be held April 28 - May 2, 2001 - move both afternoon and evening meetings to Thursday, May 3, 2001

▶ Other Considerations

... In observance of the Jewish Holiday [Rosh Hashanah] which falls on Tuesday, September 18th, it is recommended that both afternoon and evening council meetings for that day be moved to Thursday, September 20, 2001.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

√ Council Recess -

The first and second week of July have been chosen for the summer recess; these two weeks have remained a popular choice of the Council and have worked well as they include the 4th of July holiday. The last two weeks of December are fairly routine in choice and will include the new year holiday for 2002.

√ National Night Out -

This annual celebration allows for members of the Council to participate in the various neighborhood celebrations and is routinely held on the first Tuesday in August.

√ Election Dates -

There are no city-wide elections scheduled at this time for the calendar year 2001. A special election is scheduled as noted above for April 10, 2001 in Council District 1.

√ Annual Capitol to Capitol Visit

The 31st Annual Capitol to Capitol visit will take place April 28, through May 2, 2001 [Saturday-Wednesday]. It has been a past practice of the Council not to hold council meetings on the Tuesday of the trip to allow for council participation.



ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING FOUR WEEKS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2001 IN WHICH REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS NEED NOT BE HELD; RESCHEDULING OF OTHER MEETINGS REGULARLY SCHEDULED FOR TUESDAY(S) ON WHICH CONFLICTS OCCUR

WHEREAS, the City Charter, Section 31 allows for the designation of four weeks a year wherein regular City Council meetings need not be held;

WHEREAS, the City Charter, Section 31 allows for the city council to hold regular meetings at such times and places as may be fixed by resolution, except that the council shall meet after 5 p.m. not less than one evening each week;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the weeks of July 2 through July 13, 2001 and December 17, through December 31, 2001 be designated as the four weeks in which regular city council meetings need not be held;

SECTION 2. That both the afternoon and evening meetings on Tuesday, August 7, 2001 [National Night Out] be moved to Thursday, August 9, 2001;
