

Resolution of Intention No. 2703

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

57th Street from the Southerly line of M Street to the Northerly line of Folsom Boulevard by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete sidewalks, and removing concrete sidewalk and driveway where shown on Plan.

All of said work to be done in accordance with the Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers, heretofore adopted by the City Council and also in accordance with detailed Plans made therefore by the City Engineer and on file in his office, having been approved by the City Council on July 2nd, 1948., and

WHEREAS, said City Council has found and determined that pursuant to Section 2804 of Division 4 of the STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, the Owners of more than 60% of the Area of the property subject to Assessment for the above described improvement have signed and filed with the City Council a written petition and said Owners did in said petition WAIVE the proceedings required by the Special Assessment, Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931, and the said City Council does hereby approve of said WAIVER and resolves to commence Proceedings as provided in Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911.

Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers, heretofore adopted by the City Council and also in accordance with detailed Plans made therefore by the City Engineer and on file in his office having been approved by the City Council on July 9th, 1948.

Concrete curb and gutter shall be as shown on Cut # 6 and Cut #13 of said Specifications, and Concrete curb alone shall be as shown on Plan.

Cast-iron gutter drains shall be as shown on Cut # 11 of said Specifications.

Sewer Joints shall be made with G-K Sewer Joint Compound as specified in Section 13 of said Specifications.

Manhole covers shall be as shown on Cut 1-B of said Specifications.

Water Mains shall be in accordance with Standard Specifications for the installation of Water Mains, Fittings, Valves, Fire Hydrants, and Appurtenances of the Water Department of the City of Sacramento heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento.

Asphaltic concrete pavement shall be constructed as provided in Section 29 of said Specifications., and

WHEREAS, said City Council has found and determined that pursuant to Section 2804 of Division 4 of the STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, the Owners of more than 60% of the Area of the property subject to Assessment for the above described improvement, have signed and filed with the City Clerk, a written Petition, and said Owners did in said petition WAIVE the proceedings required by the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation, and Majority Protest Act of 1931, and the said City
