

RESOLUTION No. 354

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

December 14, 1945

WHEREAS, the People of the State of California have filed an action in the Superior Court of Sacramento County against the City of Sacramento for the purpose of condemning a certain portion of the Sacramento Golf Course for highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached between the representatives of both parties as to settlement of the matters involved; and

WHEREAS, execution of the proper papers necessary for final settlement is not yet complete,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That pending the final settlement of the proceedings referred to above, the State of California and its agents be and the same are hereby authorized to enter upon those premises sought to be condemned by that certain proceeding entitled "THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, acting by and through the Department of Public Works, Plaintiff, vs CITY OF SACRAMENTO, a municipal corporation, etc., Defendants, No. 71400, Dept. 3, in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of Sacramento," pending the settlement of condemnation proceedings, for the purpose of highway construction.
