SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - David L. Butler/James L. Grauer

SUMMARY:

David L. Butler/James L. Grauer have applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a raised landscape planter. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND:

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area adjacent to permittee's property 160' x 4' along the east side of 12th Street and an area 120' x 4' along the north side of H Street. The area is adjacent to the south and west property lines of County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 2-162-15 & 16.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the attached resolution be passed granting a revocable encroachment permit to David L. Butler/James L. Grauer in the area and for the purpose outlined above.

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:
DAVID L. BUTLER/JAMES L. GRAUER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of
constructing and maintaining a raised landscape planter

is hereby granted to David L. Butler/James L. Grauer, whose
address is as follows: 1717 I Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

The encroachment area is described as follows:

An area adjacent to permittee's property. An area 160' x 4' along the east side of 12th Street and an area 120' x 4' along the north side of H Street adjacent to the south and west property lines of County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 2-162-15 & 16.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 77-611, dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

2. An 8' sidewalk shall be maintained between raised landscape planter and tree planters.
