

ORDINANCE NO. 1472, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1344, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JANUARY 23, 1948, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1297, 1301, 1307, 1317, 1325, 1932, 1935 AND 1937, RESPECTIVELY OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT FEBRUARY 1, 1948," BY ADDING WORK SCHEDULE 18 TO SECTION 2 AND AMENDING SECTION 19 UNDER THE CLASSIFICATION OF "POLICE SERVICE" TO CHANGE WORK SCHEDULES 3 AND 4 TO 18, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT DECEMBER 1, 1949.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1344, Fourth Series, passed January 23, 1948, is hereby amended by adding Work Schedule 18 to Section 2 to read as follows:

WORK SCHEDULE 18

6 days per week, 8 hours per day one week and 5 days, 8 hours per day the following week and repeat - 2216 hours per year.

SECTION 2: Section 19 of Ordinance No. 1344, Fourth Series, passed January 23, 1948, under the classification of "POLICE SERVICE" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Work Schedules 3 and 4 are hereby changed to include Work Schedule 18.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure; such emergency being the necessity of creating a new work schedule for the Police Department, to take effect December 1, 1949, as heretofore approved.
