

RESOLUTION No. 875

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
December 2, 1949.

RESOLUTION VACATING A STRIP OF LAND 5'
IN WIDTH WITHIN THE 25' FRONT YARD SETBACK
OF CERTAIN LOTS IN FRUITRIDGE MANOR NO. 4.

WHEREAS, heretofore, pursuant to application of JANSEN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, owner of the following described lots in Fruitridge Manor No. 4, proceedings were had and taken before the City Council and the Planning Commission for the abandonment of a strip of land 5' in width within the 25' front yard setback of said lots in said Fruitridge Manor No. 4, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 774, Statutes of 1943; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held by the City Council on November 15, 1949, at 8 o'clock P.M. pursuant to a Resolution of Intention to vacate and notice of said hearing having been given in the manner and for the time prescribed by law, and said hearing having been held and no objection having been made by any person, and good cause appearing therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That pursuant to application of the owner above mentioned and proceedings had and taken, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND APPROVED that a strip of land 5' in width within the 25' front yard setback of the following described lots in Fruitridge Manor No. 4, be vacated, abandoned and reduced from 25 to 20 feet from the street. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California.

That the following is a description of the lots above referred to:

Lots 17, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 46, 47, 48, 59 and 60 of FRUITRIDGE MANOR NO. 4, in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California.
