SUBJECT: Status of the Shift to Curbside Waste Collection

SUMMARY:

This report informs the City Council that there has been no significant change in the number of curbside residential waste collection accounts since the implementation of new rates. On May 26, 1981, 55.1% of our customers had their waste collected at curbside since July 1, 1981, this number has only increased to 55.9%.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On May 26, 1981, the City Council requested that the Waste Removal Division report back to the Council on August 25, 1981, regards the impact the new refuse collection rates had on the number of its curbside customers.

The current number of waste collection customers and their service is as follows:


