2) Readvertise for Bids for Backhoe Services
3) Resolution Suspending Formal Competitive Bidding for Backhoe Services during the period September 1, 1982 through October 31, 1982

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Water and Sewer Division has a continuing annual requirement for backhoe services. Formal bids (Bid No. 522) were solicited and received on August 10, 1982. However, since the specifications have been revised, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the City to reject all bids, readvertise for bids and call for bids on October 12, 1982 for backhoe services during the period November 1, 1982 through August 31, 1983.

Since this requirement continues to exist and since the previous contracts for this requirement expired on August 31, 1982, it is also recommended that during the interim (September and October) the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for this requirement and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contracts with the previous four (4) successful contractors in the total estimated amount of \$28,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total estimated amount of \$28,000 for this requirement for the months of September and October, 1982, has been approved in the Water and Sewer Division's 1982/83 fiscal year budget.

The total estimated amount of \$128,000 for this requirement during the period November 1, 1982, or date of award if subsequent thereto, through August 31, 1983 has also been approved in the Water and Sewer Division's 1982/83 fiscal year budget.

SUBJECT: Recommendation of Award for Backhoe Services

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Since the Water and Sewer Division has an on-going requirement for backhoe services, various contracts for these services for the period September 1, 1977 through August 31, 1980 were awarded by the City Council to the lowest responsible bidders (see Attachment I). It was necessary to make multiple awards to insure adequate area coverage and equipment availability.

During this period, the Water and Sewer Division was instructed to use the lowest responsible bidders whenever they were available. However, since the lowest responsible bidders were not always available, there were times when the Water and Sewer Division has to pay a higher hourly rate for the required services.

Therefore, in order to minimize costs, it was determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to solicit proposals for these services for the period September 1, 1980 through August 31, 1981 at a specified total hourly rate of \$30. Various proposals were received and contracts were subsequently awarded by the City Council to those lowest responsible bidders who agreed to furnish these services at a total hourly rate of \$30 (see Attachment II). Since these contracts contained a provision allowing a one year extension at the same terms and conditions, some were extended through August 31, 1982 by the City Council. The two (2) remaining contractors had stated that they would not be able to extend at the same terms and conditions.

Since the latter approach has proven to be more effective, proposals were again solicited for these services for the period September 1, 1982 through August 31, 1983, at the same fixed hourly rate of \$30. Since all of the bidders have again agreed to furnish these services at a total hourly rate of \$30, it was again recommended that the City Council accept all of the proposals received.


FINANCIAL DATA

RECOMMENDATION




