**CITY SUPPORT OF UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS  
INITIATIVES RELATED TO THE LIFE SCIENCES**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento (City) has identified the attraction and growth of firms within the Life Sciences Industry as an economic development priority;

WHEREAS, The University of California, Davis (University) operates its Medical Center on University-owned property located within the City (the Sacramento Campus);

WHEREAS, the University desires to foster the growth of business ventures in the Sacramento Region utilizing University-developed technologies and research;

WHEREAS, the University has a need for additional research space at the Sacramento Campus and proposes to develop new facilities, a portion of which will be made available for lease by non-University entities;

WHEREAS, the University proposes formation of University Research Partners (URP), a nonprofit public benefit corporation, or a similar entity, for purposes of financing, developing, and operating a multi-phased research park facility upon the Sacramento Campus (the Project);

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Campus is located on Stockton Boulevard, which is a commercial corridor designated by the City as a priority for economic development efforts;

WHEREAS, the Project will provide substantial benefit to the City and the Stockton Boulevard Corridor in the form of new development, additional employment, and educational opportunities for citizens;

WHEREAS, the Project will be located within the City's Oak Park neighborhood which has been a focus of community revitalization efforts; and

WHEREAS, construction of the Project will contribute greatly to the revitalization of Oak Park and surrounding areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The City supports and endorses formation of University Research Partners and the proposed development of the Project upon the Sacramento Campus.
