

ORDINANCE NO. 1551, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE 15000 FEET OF 1½" GALVANIZED PIPE IN THE OPEN MARKET AND TO HAVE CERTAIN REPAIR WORK DONE TO THE ROOFS OF TWO HANGARS AT THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase 15000 FEET OF 1½" GALVANIZED PIPE in the open market, to be used for the Bing Maloney Golf Course, and to have the roofs of two hangars at the Sacramento Municipal Airport repaired. Such pipe to be purchased and such work to be done without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergencies being the immediate need of said pipe for the construction of the Bing Maloney Golf Course, and also the immediate repair of the roofs of two hangars at the Sacramento Municipal Airport, due to the wind storm on October 26, 1950.


