





SUMMARY VACATION AND ABANDONMENT OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN "V" & "W" STREETS FROM 26TH TO 27TH STREETS, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 8331 TO 8336, INCLUSIVE OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

ABANDONMENT PROCEEDING NO. 5467

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8333 to 8336, inclusive, of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, the City Council hereby vacates and abandons the following described Alley.

All that real property situate, lying, and being in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows:

All that portion of the Alley lying between "V" & "W" Streets, from the easterly right-of-way line of 26th Street to the westerly right-of-way line of 27th Street as shown on the Official Map of Plat of Sacramento City, recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Sacramento, California in Book 1 of Maps, Page 3.

(A map or plan of the proposed abandonment is on file in the office of the Director of Public Works).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council does hereby find and declare that all of the facts, as set forth in this Resolution, are true and correct; that by reason of the findings and premises aforesaid, said Alley, as above set forth and described, is hereby declared abandoned and vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Resolution, attested by the Clerk of this Council, be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Sacramento.
