RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAYDEED

WHEREAS, HENRY C. MODDISON, JOSEPHINE C. MODDISON, EMILY McADOO, ROBERT A. GUNTHER and RUTH GUNTHER have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Right-of WayDeed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

A strip of land five (5') feet in width, the description of which is as follows:

All that portion of that certain 71.25 acre tract of land described in deed executed by W. W. White et al to Henry S. Moddison, dated January 16, 1911, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on the same date in Book 326 of Deeds at page 433, described as follows:

A strip of land five (5.0) feet in width the northerly boundary of which is described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of said 71.25 acre tract, being a point on the easterly boundary of property of Central Pacific Railway Company; thence from said point of beginning North 67° 41' East 170.00 feet along the northerly boundary of said 71.25 acre tract to the northwesterly corner of a strip of land sixty feet in width, conveyed to the County of Sacramento for road purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Right-of-Way Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Right-of-Way Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
