

ORDINANCE NO. 2053, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 669, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 27, 1935, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DANCING IN PLACES WHERE LIQUORS ARE SOLD; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, THIRD SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 11, 1917; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY"; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 669, Fourth Series, passed June 27, 1935, is hereby amended by deletion of the words "and except also in a bona fide restaurant, as herein defined."


SECTION 2. Section 2 (b) of said ordinance, reading as follows: "Bona Fide Restaurant. A bona fide restaurant shall be construed to include any place where the general public is admitted and where the major business conducted therein is the furnishing and serving of food to guests at tables." is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Section 5 of said ordinance is hereby amended by deletion of the words "dancing shall be confined strictly to bona fide patrons of the restaurant."

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately. Said emergency is hereby declared to be the necessity of bringing this ordinance into harmony with the laws of the State of California.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be published once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
