


RESOLUTION No. 2126
RESOLUTION RESCINDING PROCEEDINGS
Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 7, 1927.

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the proceedings for the opening of a street eighty (80) feet in width, to be known as "Land Park Drive," extending from the north boundary of "William Land Park" to the northerly line of the property now, or formerly, owned by M. A. K. Landsburg, in the City of Sacramento, adopted September 30, 1926, under Resolution of Intention No. 2126, be, and the same are, hereby rescinded.
