**SUBJECT: 34TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS BETWEEN 28TH AVENUE AND FRUITRIDGE ROAD (PN:TJ61) - PROJECT APPROVAL AND BID ADVERTISEMENT**

**LOCATION/COUNCIL DISTRICT** 34th Street Between 28th Avenue and Fruitridge Road  
District No. 5

**SUMMARY**

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on September 16, 1992.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The proposed project extends 34th Street, 400' north of Fruitridge Road, to approximately 145' south of 28th Avenue. The improvements will provide access to a proposed youth center (La Familia Counseling Center) and include the construction of water, sewer, drainage, and roadway improvements. A paved, gated, twelve foot wide emergency access road between the extension terminus and 28th Avenue will also be constructed as part of this project.

A Negative Declaration for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on May 12, 1992. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$93,100.00.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

Additional funding is needed to complete this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$181,400. The current budget is \$100,000 which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Block Grant/Housing and Redevelopment fund 205. The funds available for this project amount to \$66,457 as of August 10, 1992. It is anticipated that the required funding will be provided from Storm Drainage and Gas Tax funds. The final recommendation will be made after bids have been received.

A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**


