

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES AND HAVE CERTAIN ELECTRICAL WORK DONE, BY CITY FORCES, AT THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain electrical supplies in the open market and also to have certain preliminary electrical work done, by city forces, prior to the beginning of construction of a new ramp at the Sacramento Municipal Airport. Such supplies to be purchased and such work to be done without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost for the completion of this work is \$2,500.00.


SECTION II: That this ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of placing electric conduit under the ground prior to the laying of the pavement for the new ramp at the Municipal Airport.
