### SUMMARY

The City has formed an assessment district for water, sewer, and drainage that includes an area outside the City limits. Staff recommends that water service be provided to this area.

### BACKGROUND

By agreement with Sacramento County, an assessment district was formed to provide water, sewer, and drainage to an area in the vicinity of Elder Creek Road and Florin Perkins Road. A water main will be installed in Elder Creek Road where one side of the street is outside the City limits. If the City does not agree to provide water service to this area, the area cannot be assessed for its share of the water main construction cost, which will be an estimated \$130,000. This \$130,000 share would either have to be spread against the property inside the City limits or paid by the City. If paid by the City, it could be collected if, and when, the outside area annexed to the City and the parcels requested water service. Staff believes the best alternative is to agree to provide water service so that this area can be assessed for its fair share of the water main cost.

### FINANCIAL

The impact of not agreeing to serve water could be a \$130,000 cost to the City, with possible future recovery, or spreading the assessment over the area within the City.

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
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RECOMMENDATION
