

ORDINANCE NO. 1621, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION AND ELECTRICAL MATERIALS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO INTERSECTION ELECTRICAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND TO HAVE THE WORK DONE BY CITY FORCES, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain construction and electrical materials for the installation of two (2) ELECTRICAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS at the intersections of:

29th and Broadway
30th and Broadway

That said work is to be done by City forces without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter.


The sum of \$4,593.28 is available to cover the cost of construction and the cost of said work is to be paid as follows:

\$ 1,896.62 - from the Gas Tax Allocation Fund for
Major Streets
\$ 2,496.65 - from State Highway Budget Funds
\$ 200.01 - from City Funds.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of installing two (2) intersection electric traffic signals without further delay, in order to promote the public safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Sacramento.
