## RESOLUTION No. 321

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 19, 1945

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento finds that it is necessary for the protection of life and property to establish a prima facie speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour upon that portion of the highway within the limits of the City of Sacramento known as "Broadway", which is within a distance of one thousand feet of the intersection of Muir Way and Broadway near the New Helvetia Housing Project and within one thousand feet of the entrance to the New Helvetia Housing Project leading from Broadway,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a prima facie speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour be hereby established upon that portion of Broadway which is within a distance of one thousand feet from the intersection of Muir Way and Broadway and also that portion of Broadway which is within a distance of one thousand feet of the entrance to the New Helvetia Housing Project which leads to Broadway, and the City Manager is hereby instructed to cause the erection of signs giving notice of such speed limit in conformity with Section 468 of the Vehicle Code.
