

RESOLUTION NO. 2596

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

October 18th, 1946

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council requesting that proceedings be adopted for the improvement of 41st Street from the northerly line of B Street and the southerly line of Rancho Village (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), and A Street from the easterly line of 43rd Street to the easterly boundary of said Rancho Village produced northerly, and a Tract of land adjacent to and contiguous with Lots 44 to 52 inclusive of said Rancho Village, and B Street from the easterly line of 43rd Street to the westerly line of La Purissima Way and 43rd Street adjacent to Lot 126 of Glenn Orchard No. 2 (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), in the City of Sacramento.

WHEREAS, the signers of said petition state that they are all of the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for assessment for said work and improvement, and they expressly WAIVE the provisions of Division 4 of the "Streets and Highways Code" of the State of California, (The Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931), as amended, and all investigations, proceedings, and reports provided for therein, and


WHEREAS, the said petition has been checked by the City Engineer's Office and found that the WAIVER is signed by the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for assessment for said work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the said petition is hereby approved and granted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds and determines that the WAIVER in said petition is signed by the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for said work and improvement and hereby directs that proceedings for said work be authorized as provided in Division 7 of the said Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911.
