

## RESOLUTION No. 584

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 16, 1948

WHEREAS, the Central California Traction Company now is, and has been for sometime past, operating a railroad within the City of Sacramento under franchise, and by the terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 895, First Series, passed June 21, 1909, permission was granted to the Company for a period of 50 years to operate beginning at "X" and 31st Streets; thence proceeding southerly on 31st Street to Broadway and continuing southerly on Broadway to Second Avenue; southerly on Second Avenue to Stockton Boulevard, and southerly on Stockton Boulevard to the city limits, which ordinance and franchise is now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, application has been received from the Central California Traction Company for permission to operate diesel power locomotives, not in excess of 70 tons, in and upon said railroad tracks for all necessary railroad purposes for the balance of the term provided for in the franchise; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended granting this application,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the Central California Traction Company is hereby granted permission to use diesel power locomotives, not in excess of 70 tons, upon the streets of this city, covered by the provisions of the franchise above mentioned, for the remainder of the term of the franchise.
