RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF PROPERTIES FOR
5TH AVENUE WIDENING.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary in connection with the Widening of 5th Avenue, between Sacramento Boulevard and Stockton Boulevard, to purchase from the following owners those certain real properties described as follows:

Joseph and Gertrude J. Pedone
N. 40' S. 160' LOT 13 "SUNSET ADDITION"
Consideration, \$125.00

Addie I. Harvey
N. 47.83' LOTS 4 and 5 "HOFFMEIER TRACT"
Consideration, \$2750.00

Robert and Elsie May McGee
S. 13 feet, more or less, of LOT 13 "EAST SIDE ADDITION
TO OAK PARK"
Consideration, \$100.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City of Sacramento purchase said properties from the owners aforesaid for the sums above quoted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Controller be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants for said sums and cause them to be deposited with the Fidelity Title Insurance Company in escrow pending delivery to the City of good and sufficient deeds conveying clear title to said properties.
