SUBJECT: Sacramento History Center - Tahara Fund

SUMMARY

The report provides information relating to the Sacramento History Center Capital Improvement Project and recommends funds from the Shige Tahara Trust Fund No. 5-60 be allocated to cover increased exhibitry costs.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento History Center Capital Improvement Project is nearing completion. On November 14, 1978, the City Council designated the unrestricted \$60,000 Tahara gift for the Sacramento History Center. On April 27, 1982, the City Council specifically allocated the Tahara gift and interest earned toward the History Center furniture. The amount allocated was \$75,000. Furniture for the Center cost \$32,825. The remaining funds (\$42,175) plus additional interest earned (estimated at \$33,000) is available for a total of \$75,175.

Exhibitry costs for the Center have risen over the last year due to delays and change orders. The Sacramento History Center, Inc., is responsible for the exhibitry costs. However, since the costs have risen significantly, it is recommended that the available Tahara Trust funds be allocated to the Sacramento History Center, Inc., to assist in the cost of the Exhibitry. Exhibit costs are estimated at \$1.2 million.


FINANCIAL DATA

\$42,175 is available in the Tahara Trust Fund plus unallocated interest earned estimated at \$33,000 previously allocated to the History Center furniture.


RECOMMENDATION
