

ORDINANCE NO. 1104, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The sum of \$11,807.50 is hereby appropriated to Sanitary Fill in the Division of Streets Budget, in addition to the sums heretofore appropriated for the 1945-46 fiscal year, to be applied as follows:

Salaries & Wages.....	\$ 5,450.00
Service & Expense.....	5,610.00
Material & Supplies.....	242.50
Repairs & Replacements.....	250.00
Additions & Betterments.....	255.00

SECTION 2: The sum of \$5,705.00 is hereby transferred from Budget No. 44 Disposal (Sanitary Disposal Co.), heretofore appropriated, to the Division of Streets Budget as set out in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3: The sum of \$6,102.50 is hereby appropriated out of available funds for the purposes and in the manner set out in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate appropriation of this money is necessary to carry on the functions of the City of Sacramento Government.
