

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-428

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 13, 2006

INCREASING REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BUDGETS BY RECOGNIZING THE CURRENT YEAR QUIMBY IN LIEU FEE REVENUES, FUND 710, BY \$250,000

BACKGROUND:

- A. On February 25, 2003, the City Council approved the park name, master plan, and the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Westlake Community Park, a 10.0 acre community park.
- B. On November 15, 2005, Resolution No. 2005-830 (Attachment 1, pages 4-5) approved the transfer of \$750,000 from Quimby Act Fund, Fund 710, to CIP LS78 for Phase II development of Westlake Community Park.
- C. Only \$500,000 was transferred to CIP LS78 since there was not adequate funding in the Quimby Act Fees, Fund 710, contingency to transfer the full \$750,000.
- D. There are adequate funds in Quimby Act Fees, Fund 710, to appropriate the remaining \$250,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Increases revenue and expenditure budgets by recognizing the current year Quimby In Lieu Fee revenues, Fund 710, by \$250,000.
