## RESOLUTION CANCELLING TAXES

WHEREAS, on the W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 2 and the E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 2 in the block bounded by "W"- "X", 8-9 Streets, there is a structure which appears to be used as a church by the "Church of God in Christ", and

WHEREAS, the City Assessor thought the structure was simply a basement and not in use and, therefore, assessed it, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the officers of the church have filed the usual affidavit for exemption for years 1940 and 1941, and, 1942, and

WHEREAS, the assessments for these years were erroneous,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the delinquent taxes, amounting to \$81.78, on this property be, and the same are hereby, cancelled.
