

RESOLUTION No. 763

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, Regular Municipal Election of the City of Sacramento for the purpose of electing nine (9) members of the City Council for a term of two (2) years beginning January 1, 1938 will be held on date of November 2, 1937; and

WHEREAS, certain proposed Charter Amendments are to be submitted to the Qualified Electors of the City of Sacramento at Special Election to be held on date of November 2, 1937, in accordance with provisions of Resolution No. 762, adopted by the City Council on date of September 10, 1937, and also on said date of November 2, 1937 shall be held under Section 242 of the Charter, a referendum election on Ordinance No 740, Fourth series, as ordered by Resolution No 708, passed August 5th, 1937.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for the purpose of holding Regular Municipal Election to elect nine (9) members of the City Council for a term of two (2) years beginning January 1, 1938, and for the purpose of holding Special Municipal Election for the purpose of submitting to the Qualified Electors of the City of Sacramento certain proposed Charter Amendments in accordance with provisions of Resolution No 762, adopted by the City Council on date of September 10, 1937, and for purpose of holding referendum election on Ordinance No. 740, Fourth series, that foregoing Elections are hereby consolidated and the Election Precincts, Polling Places, Voting Booths, Ballots and Election Officers, respectively, shall in every case be the same, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give notice thereof accordingly.
