## AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF BID AND PURCHASE OF PROPERTY FOR GRAVEL PIT


RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that authorization is hereby given to purchase approximately 1-3/4 acre of land which lies immediately south of the City of Sacramento's holding known as the "Gravel Pit," said property being approximately 192 feet fronting on Folsom Boulevard and 400 feet in depth, for the price of \$1000.00;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are, hereby authorized to execute a bid to the Superior Court conducting the proceedings of the MCGILLIVRAY ESTATE to purchase an undivided one-half interest, said bid being conditioned upon the City's being able to purchase from the owners thereof the remaining undivided one-half interest; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Controller be, and he is, hereby directed to issue a warrant in the amount of \$500.00, to be paid to the Superior Court for the purchase of the undivided one-half interest owned by the MCGILLIVRAY ESTATE.
