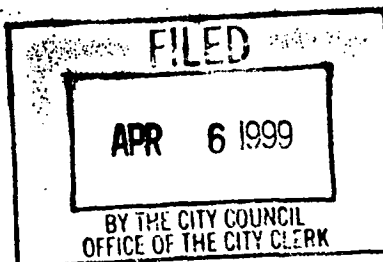

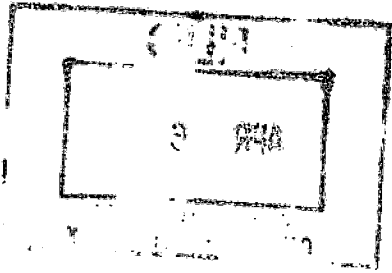
SUMMARY

The Gardenland/Northgate Neighborhood Association has been invited to present a Neighborhood Report to the City Council which will include issues, concerns, and accomplishments for its community.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

One of the responsibilities of the Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department is to serve as a liaison with neighborhood associations and residents to improve their communities and to address various issues and problems. This provides the staff with the opportunity to work closely with active





neighborhood residents, associations, and businesses. The Gardenland/Northgate Neighborhood Association, located in Area 4, has been invited to present a Neighborhood Report to the City Council. The association presentation will focus primarily on the following:

- ▶ Efforts to control the off-site sale of alcohol on Northgate Boulevard;

This is an informational item which does not require environmental review.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS



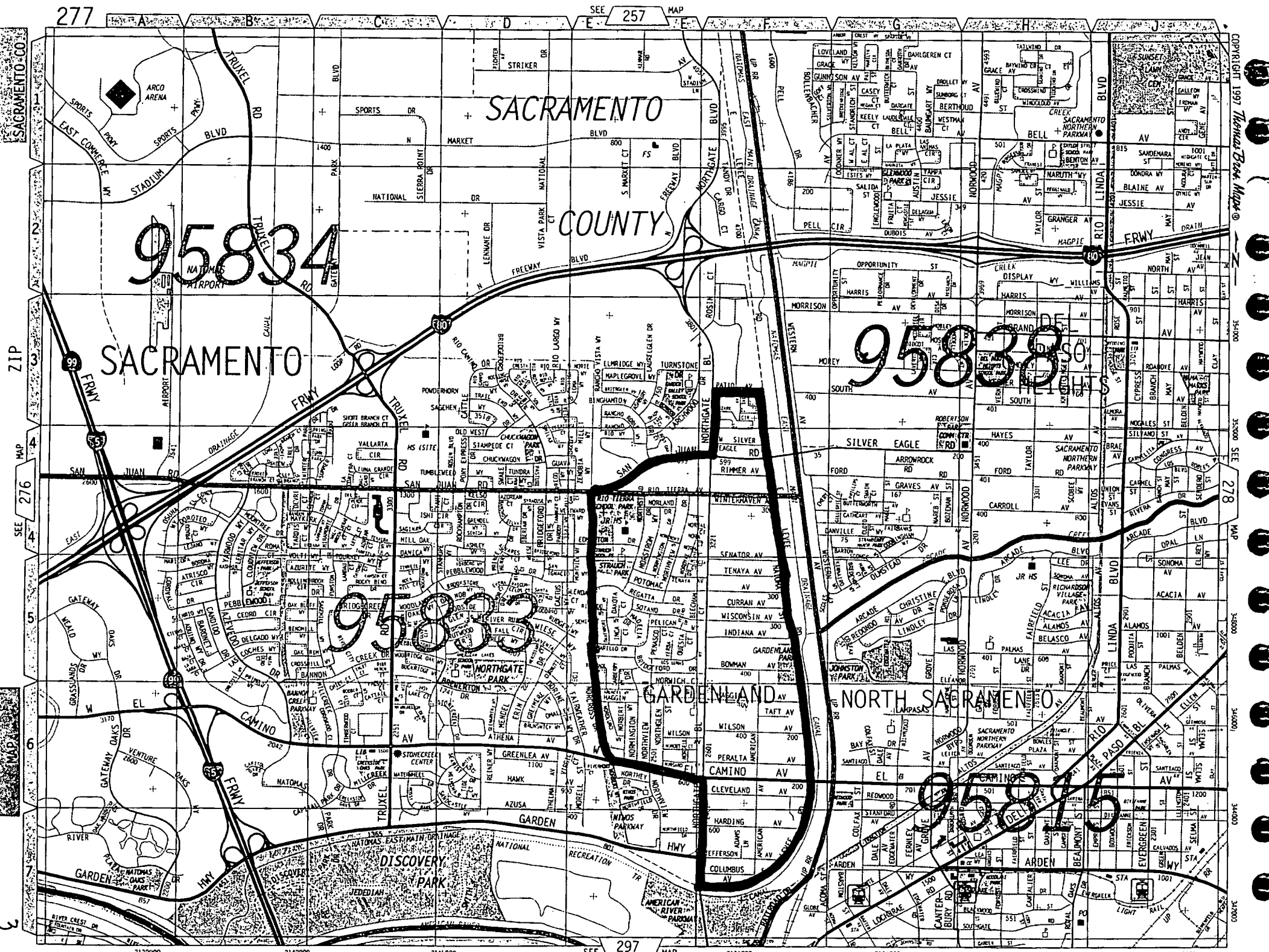
