

ORDINANCE NO. 1614, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1579, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 1, 1951, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1344, 1357, 1364, 1369, 1373, 1377, 1378, 1380, 1385, 1388, 1389, 1391, 1393, 1400, 1409, 1412, 1424, 1425, 1438, 1453, 1456, 1464, 1472, 1479, 1499, 1504, 1512, 1518, 1522, 1527, 1530, 1538, 1539, 1542, 1548, 1553, 1554, 1563 and 1567 RESPECTIVELY OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY;" AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The classification and compensation plan designated in Ordinance No. 1579, Fourth Series, is hereby amended by adding the following classifications and salary ranges:




SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of creating two new classifications for the Police Department, that of Police Patrolman (Detective) and Police Sergeant (Detective), to be effective October 1, 1951.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
