RESOLUTION No. 23

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

January 20, 1972

Whereas, on December 9, 1971, the bid of Cioli Landscaping, Inc., for the construction of improvements at the Mark Hopkins Park Site was accepted by the Sacramento City Council, and

Whereas, Cioli Landscaping, Inc., inadvertently listed Bruno Da Re Company as the subcontractor for the concrete work by two separate listings, and inadvertently omitted listing a subcontractor for the comfort station, and

Whereas, Cioli Landscaping, Inc., intended to list R & H Construction Company as the subcontractor for the comfort station, and

Whereas, Cioli Landscaping, Inc., does not possess the state contractor's license required to perform the work on the Comfort station, and R & H Construction Company possesses the license required to perform the work on the comfort station, and

Whereas, it therefore is necessary that the work on the comfort station be subcontracted, and

Whereas, permission of the Sacramento City Council is required to allow Cioli Landscaping, Inc., to subcontract the work on the Comfort Station.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. That the Sacramento City Council finds public necessity requires that the work on the comfort station be subcontracted.
- 2. That the Sacramento City Council hereby grants Cioli Landscaping, Inc., permission to subcontract the work on the comfort station to R & H Construction Company.
