

ORDINANCE NO. 1523, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE FIREWORKS IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, FIREWORKS to be used for the 4th of July celebration. The cost of said fireworks not to exceed the sum of \$1500.00.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the use of said fireworks for the 4th of July celebration.
