**SUBJECT: Report on Bids for CONSTRUCTION OF PLAY AREA AND SOFTBALL BACKSTOP AT CAMELLIA SCHOOL**

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed pending recommendation of bid award at a later date.

BACKGROUND:

On June 24, 1980 the City Council approved plans and specifications for CONSTRUCTION OF PLAY AREA AND SOFTBALL BACKSTOP AT CAMELLIA SCHOOL and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on July 15, 1980. The bids received are as follows:
