

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-151

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SELMA STREET BOUNDED BY EL CAMINO AVENUE, CLAY STREET, LEXINGTON STREET AND DIXIEANNE AVENUE WITHIN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 (TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE PROCEEDING NO. TSC04-01)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. In accordance with Section 21101.4 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California and Chapter 12.16 of the Sacramento City Code, on March 2, 2004, City Council conducted a public hearing to consider approval of the temporary closure of the following street:

Selma Street bounded by El Camino Avenue, Clay Street, Lexington Street and Dixieanne Avenue (TSC04-01).


2. Based upon substantial evidence present in the record of the proceedings regarding this matter, City Council hereby makes the following findings:
 - There is serious and continual criminal activity in the area of the street recommended for temporary closure. This finding is based upon a recommendation of the Police Department.
 - The street recommended for temporary closure is under the City's jurisdiction and has not been designated as a through highway or arterial street.
 - Vehicular or pedestrian traffic in the street recommended for temporary closure contributes to the criminal activity that is occurring there.
 - The closure will not adversely affect traffic flow, safety on the adjacent streets or in the surrounding neighborhoods, the operation of emergency vehicles, the performance of municipal or public utility services, or the delivery of freight by commercial vehicles in the area of the alley proposed to be temporarily closed.

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3. City Council finds and determines that the temporary closure of the subject street will substantially alleviate the existing serious and continual criminal activity in that street.
4. City Council grants this temporary closure of the street with the following conditions:
 - a. A gate and signs shall be installed and constructed at the entrance to Selma Street to the satisfaction of Public Works Department.
 - b. A gate security device approved by the Sacramento Fire Department shall be installed on the gates.
 - c. City departments and utility companies shall have twenty-four (24) hour access to their facilities within the street.
 - d. The applicant shall keep the area of the temporary street closure clear, and clean from debris.
 - e. The applicant shall apply and obtain a revocable encroachment permit and an excavation permit from the Public Works Department for the installation of the gate and signs. The revocable encroachment permit is to be issued simultaneously with this resolution. The excavation permit, if required, may be issued subsequent to this resolution, but must be obtained prior to the construction of improvements in the public right-of-way.
