SUBJECT: Expand Scope of Project - Strawberry Manor Park Development (LC31)

SUMMARY

This report provides information regarding the Strawberry Manor Park Development CIP project and requests authorization to expand the scope of the project to include a basketball court and related amenities.

No additional city funds are requested.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Strawberry Manor Park is the only developed park land serving approximately 8,000 residents of the Strawberry Manor section of Del Paso Heights. Funds for the redevelopment of the park were provided by a Federal Land and Water Conservation grant of \$30,583 and city matching General Fund monies of \$30,000 included in the FY 1986-87 City CIP budget. To date, antiquated playground equipment has been replaced with a modern tot lot/adventure area, bench, picnic table, drinking fountain, and irrigation modifications.

A fund balance of approximately \$13,783 remains in this project. Staff recommends that the scope of this project be expanded to include a basketball court. The recommendation to build a basketball court was based on the community's favorable response to the idea through a mail-in survey. Provisions of the grant provide for this type of project expansion.

FINANCIAL DATA

The Strawberry Manor Park Development project (LC31) currently has a fund balance of \$13,783 in General Fund monies. The cost of building a basketball court at Strawberry Manor Park is estimated at approximately \$13,500. No additional city funds are requested.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve this report and refer it to the full City Council for action. In addition, it is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize expansion of the scope of the Strawberry Manor Park Development project to include construction of a basketball court and related amenities.
