

# RESOLUTION No. 717

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, a petition by about four hundred residents of the southeastern part of the City have petitioned the City Council to procure for them better transportation, and

WHEREAS, it appears to said Council that a plan could be worked out by extension of a bus route, which at but a small extra cost of operation would furnish better service to this area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager, for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento, petition the Railroad Commission to make a survey of this area, and recommend such changes in bus routes as will, in its opinion, furnish reasonably adequate transportation to the residents in such area; and to order and direct the Pacific Gas & Electric Company to install such recommended changes in a reasonable time.
