On January 7, 2002, a representative of our firm visited the Central Machining facility at 8270 Belvedere Avenue, Suite 110, Sacramento, CA 95826, to perform an inspection of five installed machines.

Four machines are computer controlled metalworking machines, imported from Taiwan. All items are new equipment, connected to electricity and air supply, and operational. Also, a new air compressor that supports the operation of the machines was inspected.

**The inspected equipment is described as follows:**

- Yeong Chin Machine Co, Computer controlled machine, unit No. 1
- Yeong Chin Machine Co, Computer controlled machine, unit No. 2
- Yeong Chin Machine Co, Computer controlled machine, unit No. 3
- Yeong Chin Machine Co, Computer controlled machine, unit No. 4
- Atlas Copco Air compressor


All items of equipment are powered by three phase, 208 volts, from a nearby panel. Grounding checks with a digital voltmeter indicated that the equipment was electrically grounded. Wire sizing was adequate.

The equipment met the inspection standards and acceptance stickers were applied.
