

RESOLUTION NO. 90

WHEREAS, heretofore the Northern Electric Company, a corporation, caused to be executed to the City of Sacramento a bond in the sum of \$2500.00 by the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company to guarantee performance of conditions embodied in Ordinance No. 761 of the City of Sacramento, which ordinance was passed November 26th, 1906; and

WHEREAS, it appears that no authority existed for the requiring of said bond and that there is no consideration therefor, and that the same does not operate in any degree for the benefit of the City of Sacramento, and the result thereof is only expense for premiums to the successor in interest of the said Northern Electric Company, a corporation,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said bond referred to in the preamble of this resolution be, and the same is hereby, cancelled, and the City Controller is authorized to surrender the same to the successor in interest of the said Northern Electric Company, a corporation.
