It is with great pleasure the Sacramento Chinese Sportsmen's Club would like to offer to the City of Sacramento a Fish Cleaning Facility to be located at Garcia Bend Park. The members of our sportsmen's club voted for the construction of this facility to complement the existing popular river-oriented park now in great use by boaters and fishermen.

The facility is a large steel-welded, fiber-glassed over table tray with cutting surfaces suitable for cleaning your catch from the nearby river. It will be mounted at counter height on post supports. Plumbing for running water and connection to existing waste disposal units will also be provided.

This facility has been designed and engineered by members. Construction and installation will be done by members and their friends. Total cost of plans, materials, and labor is to be borne by our club.

The project has been discussed at great length with Solon "Doc" Wisham, Community Services Director. We want to thank "Doc" and members of the Parks and Recreation Division for their assistance in review and approval of our plans.

We would be honored to appear before you to receive your acceptance of our offer to the community and answer any questions you may have. It is also our club's desire to continue to co-sponsor the Kids Fishing Derbies at Southside Park as we have in the past twenty plus years with your Parks and Recreation Division. We, too, are proud to have been a participant for establishment of the Tropical Bird Cage in the new William Land Park Zoo.
