ALLOCATION OF MACHINIST HELPER CLASS
TO MONTHLY SALARY RANGE (CONT'D)

Mr. Lennis Tupper, representing Machinists Union Local #2182; Joe Slocumb, Plant Maintenance Supervisor in the Water Department; Harry Finks, representing Sacramento Labor Council; and Paul Callander and Robert Jenkins, Machinist Helpers in the Water Department, were present and outlined their objections to the proposal to place this class by monthly salary range in place of the present hourly rate. Recommendation was made by Mr. Slocumb that the hourly rate for this class be established at 80% of the Journeyman Machinist rate under the Construction Industries contract.

Secretary advised that since 1951, hourly rate increases have been applied to the Machinist Helper class in the same amount as the increases applied to the Machinist class with the result that had the 20¢ per hour increase been applied on July 1, 1963, the hourly rate for Machinist Helper would have represented 87.6% of the hourly rate for Machinist.

After general discussion, motion was made by Mr. Street that the class of Machinist Helper continue to be paid on an hourly rate basis, at a percentage of the rate for Machinist to be determined at a later date, but prior to the next scheduled increase in the Construction Industries contract on August 1, 1964. Motion was seconded by Mr. Genshlea and carried by the following vote:
