RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND APPROVING THE POWER RIDGE/SUMP 43 DETENTION BASIN PROJECT (WA66)

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has determined the need for the Power Ridge/Sump 43 Detention Basin Project for flood protection (hereinafter called the "Project"), and has included the Project in the City of Sacramento Capital Improvements Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has conducted an initial study to determine if the Project may have a significant effect on the environment, and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study concludes that there is no substantial evidence that the Project, or any of its aspects, may cause a significant effect on the environment and a Negative Declaration is therefore appropriate, and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study concluded that the Project involves no potential for any adverse effect, either individually or cumulatively on wildlife resources, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has circulated the proposed Negative Declaration on the Project for public review, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The City Council hereby ratifies and approves the Negative Declaration and mitigation reporting program for the Power Ridge/Sump 43 Detention Basin Project, finding on the basis of the Initial Study and comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment.
2. The City Council hereby approves the implementation of the Power Ridge/Sump 43 Detention Basin Project.


