

RESOLUTION No. 339

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 25, 1947

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been established by the people of the City of Sacramento, a municipal court, superseding the police and justice's courts, and

WHEREAS, there has been introduced in the State Legislature S. B. 383 and A. B. 749, for the purpose of effecting certain salary increases for the judges and attaches of said court, and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that the establishment of the municipal court in Sacramento has brought about a more speedy and efficient administration of justice than that which prevailed in the three superseded courts, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento, after careful investigation and consideration of the above mentioned bills, believes that the same should be enacted into law; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in regular session assembled, that the Sacramento County representatives in the State Legislature use their best efforts to secure the enactment of the above mentioned bills and respectfully request the Governor of California to approve the same.
